HOLY BAPTISM

PRESENTATION

In Holy Baptism our gracious heavenly Father liberates us from sin and death by joining us to the death and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. We are born children of a fallen humanity; in the waters of Baptism we are reborn children of God and inheritors of eternal life. By water and the Holy Spirit we are made members of the Church which is the body of Christ. As we live with him and with his people, we grow in faith, love, and obedience to the will of God.

We present Blake Quinn Mansilla to receive the Sacrament of Holy Baptism.

In Christian love you have presented Blake for Holy Baptism. You should, therefore, faithfully bring *him* to the services of God's house, and teach *him* the Lord's Prayer, the Creed, and the Ten Commandments. As *he grows* in years, you should place in *his* hands the Holy Scriptures and provide for *his* instruction in the Christian faith, that, living in the covenant of their Baptism and in communion with the Church, *he* may lead a *godly life* until the day of Jesus Christ.

Do you promise to fulfill these obligations?

Pour out your Holy Spirit, so that *Blake* who *is to be* baptized may be given new life. Wash away his sin, cleanse him by this water, and bring him forth as an *inheritor* of your glorious kingdom.

To you be given praise and honor and worship through your Son, Jesus Christ our Lord, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, now and forever.


P Lift up your hearts.

Christ has died. Christ is risen. Christ will come again.


Therefore, gracious Father, with this bread and cup


